## PROGRAM SCHEDULE

WHEN	WHAT'S HAPPENING?	HOW TO JOIN IN!
DAY 1: <b>MONDAY</b> <b>24 FEB</b>	<b>9AM — 9PM</b> Our team will set up the basic structure for the installation. In the afternoon, we begin to bring in all the rope materials collected from all over Melbourne that will make up <i>Home Bound</i> .	<b>Bring your ropes:</b> contribute to <i>Home Bound</i> by donating your ropes and fibres.
DAY 2: <b>TUESDAY</b> <b>25 FEB</b>	<b>5PM — 9PM</b> Arborist and Shibari artist Ash Snare and members of Rope Dojo Melbourne weave rope webs onto the <i>Home Bound</i> structure.	<b>Hang in there:</b> help us weave the rope webs. We will show you how.
DAY 3: <b>WEDNESDAY</b> <b>26 FEB</b>	<b>5PM — 9PM</b> Members of the Handweavers and Spinners Guild of Victoria spin yarn while contemporary knitter Andrew Chan uses knitting machines to produce long stretches of knitted fabric that wrap around the <i>Home Bound</i> structure.	<b>Spin that wheel:</b> have a go on the spinning wheels and Andrew Chan's knitting machines.
DAY 4: <b>THURSDAY</b> <b>27 FEB</b>	<b>5PM — 6PM</b> Visual artist Dr Vicki Couzens hosts a Yarning Circle with our collaborating artists and community leaders to discuss ideas around home and Country, crafts and culture.	<b>Have a yarn:</b> listen to the stories of different people who call Melbourne home.
	<b>6PM — 9PM</b> Dr Vicki Couzens and Lisa Love lead up in weaving a giant dilly bag into <i>Home Bound</i> with their family and mob.	<b>Familial lines:</b> experience traditional weaving with unconventional materials and appreciate the significance of this craft to the Keerray Wooroong Gunditjmara Peoples of Western Victoria.
DAY 5: <b>FRIDAY</b> <b>28 FEB</b>	<b>9AM — 12PM</b> Visual artist Chaco Kato creates beautiful webs of yarn with fellow artists and participants.	<b>World wide web:</b> help us weave the yarn webs. We will show you how.
	<b>5PM — 9PM</b> Contemporary knitter Andrew Chan leads a group of movement artists in an arm knitting activity. Circus aerialists from One Fell Swoop take it all up into the air.	<b>All tied up:</b> watch the artists perform meditative choreography.

	<b>5PM — 9PM</b>	Mhubo Suleiman and Qaymi Art & Crafts weave a traditional Somali Aqal hut and weave it into <i>Home Bound</i> .	<b>Somali attachments:</b> help us weave the Aqal. We will show you how.
DAY 7: <b>SUNDAY</b> 2 MAR	<b>9AM — 12PM</b>	Chaco Kato, Rosa Vasseghi and the Ava Tapestry Group add to the <i>Home Bound</i> installation through macramé techniques.	<b>Make macramé:</b> apply your macramé skills or learn the basics. We will show you how.
DAY 8: <b>MONDAY</b> 3 MAR	<b>9AM — 12PM</b>	Rosa Vasseghi and the Ava Tapestry Group add to the <i>Home Bound</i> installation through crochet.	<b>Crochet okay:</b> bring your hook and apply your crochet skills or learn the basics. We will show you how.
	<b>9AM — 9PM</b>	Textile artist Yu Fang Chi uses nets to create a beautiful installation that adds to <i>Home Bound</i> .	<b>Set with nets:</b> watch the artist at work or lend her a hand.
DAY 9: <b>TUESDAY</b> 4 MAR	<b>7PM — 9PM</b>	The Richmond Scouts and Venturers show us how it's done by turning <i>Home Bound</i> into a comfy campsite.	<b>Show you the ropes:</b> pitch a tent, hang a hammock and tie some survival knots with guidance from the scouts.
DAY 10: <b>WEDNESDAY</b> 5 MAR	<b>9AM — 9PM</b>	Contemporary fibre and sculpture artists Amber Lucy and Carolyn Cardinet respond to <i>Home Bound</i> through their unique approaches.	<b>Tying up loose ends:</b> watch the artists at work or lend them a hand.
DAY 11: <b>THURSDAY</b> 6 MAR	<b>6PM — 8PM</b>	Artist Yu Fang Chi leads the Joeys and Cubs of Richmond Scouts in a rope making challenge.	<b>Scouts skills:</b> watch or take part in the rope weaving activity. Or jump into a Joeys vs. Cubs tug-of-war!
DAY 12: <b>FRIDAY</b> 7 MAR	<b>5PM — 9PM</b>	Shibari artist Ash Snare and members of Rope Dojo Melbourne respond to the knotty cornucopia that is <i>Home Bound</i> with artful suspensions and playful intimacy in a Rope Jam.	<b>Intimate bonds:</b> watch these bondage experts at play.

Some of them may get carried away and knit themselves into <i>Home Bound</i> as Blu Jay, Julai, MaggZ and Nupu show off queer knit creations on a makeshift catwalk.	<b>The knitty gritty ball:</b> bring your knitting needles and show off your skills or learn the basics. We will show you how. Hang out and enjoy the knitting spectacle.
DAY 14: <b>SUNDAY</b> <b>9 MAR</b>	<b>5PM — 6PM</b> Dr Vicki Couzens, Lisa Love & Tarryn Love bring all our collaborators together for another (bigger) Yarning Circle.	<b>Social ties:</b> listen to who is represented in <i>Home Bound</i> or count yourself in to be represented too.
	<b>6PM — 9PM</b> As a celebration for everyone who has been involved with <i>Home Bound</i> , our DJ will play tunes inspired from music from around the world. Accompanied by singing, dancing and more weaving.	<b>Wind it up:</b> dance, sing and weave!
DAY 15: <b>MONDAY</b> <b>10 MAR</b>	<b>9AM — 9PM</b> All our collaborators and participants return to undo <i>Home Bound</i> .	<b>Unravel together:</b> help us unravel the installation and take a piece of the massive social tapestry home with you.
